





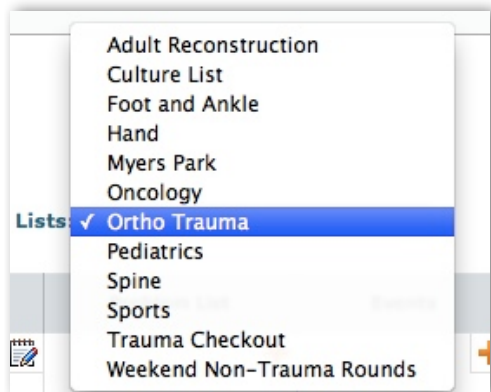
theList.md is a new way for resident teams to organize their patient information. It is a HIPAA compliant & highly secure web application designed by physicians. By using theList.md to store the patient list, sign out and tasks, your entire team can literally be "on the same page". Here is how it works:

Patient List

See all your patients on one list. Make edits quickly and easily from the home page using pop-ups. Sort by name, location or attending.

Disclosure triangles (▶) allow rows to be expanded to view complete patient details.



Multiple Lists

Residents can access other teams' list, admit and discharge patients to any team.

Additional lists can be used to for conferences, special follow up clinic or other purposes, such as tracking culture results.

Events

Events such as admission, procedures and status changes can be tracked, with days elapsed automatically updated.

This is especially helpful for surgical teams tracking postoperative days in patients who have had multiple procedures.

Medications

Keep track of selected medications, such as those relevant to the patient's admitting diagnosis.

If a start date is given, the application will automatically update medication days. This is particularly useful for drugs such as antibiotics.

Sign Out

Add dated signout notes to any patient. The most current and past sign out notes are always visible to all team members.

Sign out can be organized by system ("heme", "ID", etc.), by adding optional titles. This way, covering residents can quickly and accurately respond when called on complex patients.

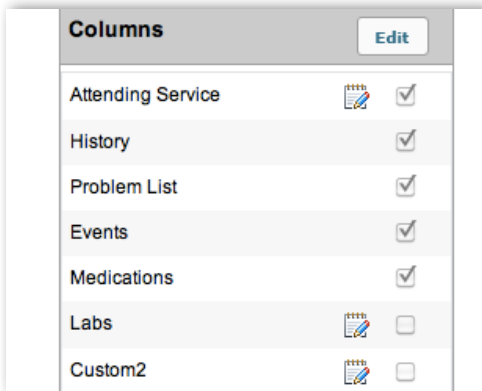
All team members can immediately tell which items are completed and which are still pending by checking the home page. Click the patient's name for an "audit trail" of completed tasks

Readable Printout

The print function organizes patient information into easy-to-read bullet points. Users can select which columns to print at the time of printing, so that covering residents are not inundated with unnecessary information.



Customize

Teams can customize theList.md to their needs by selecting which columns to display and which to leave out.

Additional "custom" columns can also be configured for specific needs, e.g. patients' diets. Customization is performed within the application - no need to contact customer support

Pricing

theList.md is provided to residency programs as a subscription service. Support is included. There is no long term contract, set up or cancellation fee nor limit on the number of user accounts.

Below is our current pricing, all amounts monthly, [\$] = credit card price or 1 year pre-pay:

- 1 list: free (max 20 patients)
- 2 lists: \$99 [\$49]
- 3- 5 lists: \$149 [\$99]
- 6-15 lists: \$199 [\$149]
- unlimited: \$249 [\$199]

- 0-5 programs - above pricing
- 6-10 programs - 50% discount
- unlimited - \$2499
